### Admissions Primary 1 and Early Years (Nursery)

#### **Online P1 School Admissions**

If your child's fifth birthday is between 1st March 2021 and 28th February 2022, you can register them in **January 2021** to start attending school in August 2021. As with last year, we are using the online P1 school admission form below, but please note this will only be available from enrolment week which is **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021**:

Parents/Carers are being invited to complete the online application form for a school in their catchment area. Where a parent/carer wishes to place their child at a school outwith their catchment area, they have been asked to complete an out of zone placing request too. With COVID restrictions in place, parents/carers are asked to email supporting documents such as a child's birth certificate and recent utility bill as proof of address or alternatively take them with them when the pupil starts school.

Again, we thought this would be fitting because of Neil's employment background being a link to STEM.

Many thanks to Neil's family and Hunting Energy Services for their very kind and generous donations at such a sad time. We hope they agree that we have put the money to very good use.

#### **Parent appointment feedback**

Many thanks to the 35 parents and carers who took the time to complete the online questionnaire about our recent parent teacher phonecalls.

69% said a phone call was as informative as a face to face meeting.

17% said it wasn't as informative as a face to face meeting.

14% said it was their first parent teacher conversation so had nothing to compare it to.

40% said that they prefer a face to face meeting.

14% said that they prefer phonecalls.

46% said that they had no preference.

We will probably have to conduct our next round of interviews by phone as restrictions will probably not have lifted enough to allow visitors into the building by March, but when they do, we may be able to offer one night of phonecalls and one night of face to face meetings.

## COVID
