### COVID

Please find updated information along with this Newsletter from Parent Club. Restrictions easing is good news. But it's important we follow the steps below to help everyone, including school and childcare staff, to stay safe.

- Continue to wear a face covering at drop-off and pick-up time
- Limit to one adult at drop-off and pick-up time
- Keep 2 metres away from other adults
- Avoid car shares and limit taking public transport

We have no fans nor windows in our Hall, therefore we will continue to go outdoors for PE, until we are in Level 1, when this should be permitted.
