With less than 2 weeks to go until the October holidays, there are some items of information that I need to share with you.

Home school folder

Today, you will receive your child's Home School Folder for you to look through, unless your child is in P3/4. Due to Mrs Brooks being absent last week, this class's folders will come home next Monday. The folders will contain any written work that your child has completed the previous week. There will, of course, be other activities that will not be represented in this folder because they are active eg PE, Music or Drama. You may also be sent information via Marvellous Me which shows work completed. The idea is for you to see examples of the work your child might typically do in a week and for you and your child to have an opportunity to discuss their learning. We hope you will enjoy the chance to see your child's work and ask that you complete the feedback sheet before returning the folder to school by **next Monday** please. Thank you.

Whole school trip to Aberdeen Arts centre to see Rapunzel

You will be aware that we have booked for P1-7 to visit Aberdeen Arts centre on the morning of Thursday 21 December to see the panto, Rapunzel. We used to go to Aberdeen every second year to see a Panto before Covid so are very excited to be able to do this again. The Parent Council are kindly paying for the buses but, where possible, parents and carers are asked to pay for their child's ticket which costs £10 by 15 December. You are welcome to pay in instalments if this is helpful. As in previous years, no child will miss out if a family is unable to afford to pay.
